

Key Stage 2 Creative Curriculum

- prepares pupils at the school for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life.

At Key Stage 2 the Creative Curriculum provides a topic title, alongside the subjects to cover within the topic. Individual targets should be taken from bsquared for each of the subjects, and incorporated into one plan for the topic.
